	OPTIONAL: Complete Career Interest Profiler $(20 - 25 \text{ min.})$ - The profiler is an online career interest assessment for students based on Holland's interest codes.
	OPTIONAL: Road Trip Nation (20 min.) - Students will explore the Road Trip Nation Interview Archive by interests and themes to expose them to potential careers in their areas of interest.
	OPTIONAL: MI Advantage (20 min.) Uses multiple intelligences theory to generate comprehensive, personalized report covering the nine distinct intelligences
	OPTIONAL: Learning Style Inventory (20 min.) Identifies student's environmental, emotional, and sociological and physical preferences to create the best possible learning environment at school and home
