Registration Process

1. Login to student Infinite Campus Account
2. Click Academic Planner
3. Update Course Plan for all grade levels
4. Check Academic Progress to see your chart. You should have NO RED spaces. If you have a red space you need to CHANGE or ADD something to your Academic Planner.
5. Finish Naviance Student tasks BY MARCH 1!
6. Ask your counselor if you need help!
7. Final check of Academic Planner to register in Junior Seminar on March 1.



ALL students must have completed their Career and College Readiness Online Curriculum through the Naviance Student program BEFORE MARCH 1st.

Each year students are required to complete tasks related to career and college planning to earn .25 elective credit for graduation. Students must complete tasks in this system to earn their credit. Many students still have tasks to complete to earn their .25 credit for online curriculum.

Use NAVIANCE to:

- search for careers and colleges
- take career interest assessments
- request transcripts
- request recommendations
- meet with college reps at CHS
- complete college applications

DISTRICT TESTING

ALL JUNIORS will be taking the ASVAB OR THE ACT for FREE on **Thursday, March 21**. Students will register for the exam during junior seminar on March 1. Students must register before the exam or they will NOT receive their scores.

Senior Year Plus-

If you plan to take online classes at a post-secondary institution (i.e. DMACC online) next fall, please sign up with the [google form](#) that was emailed. You will also need to complete the DMACC registration form in April for online classes in the fall. Check your email! **Students must be proficient on the ISASP to take any college course.**

SENIOR PARENT INFORMATION

We have added parents to the Class of 2025 Google Classroom. Parents can ask their student to send them an invite. We will be hosting a Senior Seminar on the 1st Thursday of the Month at 10:45am. All seniors are required to attend. More information will be sent in the fall.

College Visits

Each junior can take one day to go on a college visit. Many colleges host Junior Days throughout the spring. These dates are posted on the counseling bulletin board, website, & twitter. Students must sign out of your classes for the day and have a parent permission form completed. (As a senior you receive 2 days to make college visits.)

Sign up in Naviance to visit with the College Reps visiting CHS.

ICAN – FREE Assistance with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA is required to receive any type of financial aid at most institutions.
