

The Healthy Kids Act requires every student to complete a course that leads to certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) by the end of grade 12. This course is designed to cover this requirement. If you would like to get a certification after completion there will be a fee of \$5, otherwise there is no fee for this course. **If you are currently CPR certified or you have been CPR certified at some point during high school you can show us your certificate of completion and you will NOT have to take this course.**

Please complete the ONLINE portion of the CPR class by FEBRUARY 1. Once you complete the course online you need to send a copy of your completion certificate to Mrs. Hoffmann at erin.hoffmann@carlislecsd.org or turn in a copy to the counseling office.

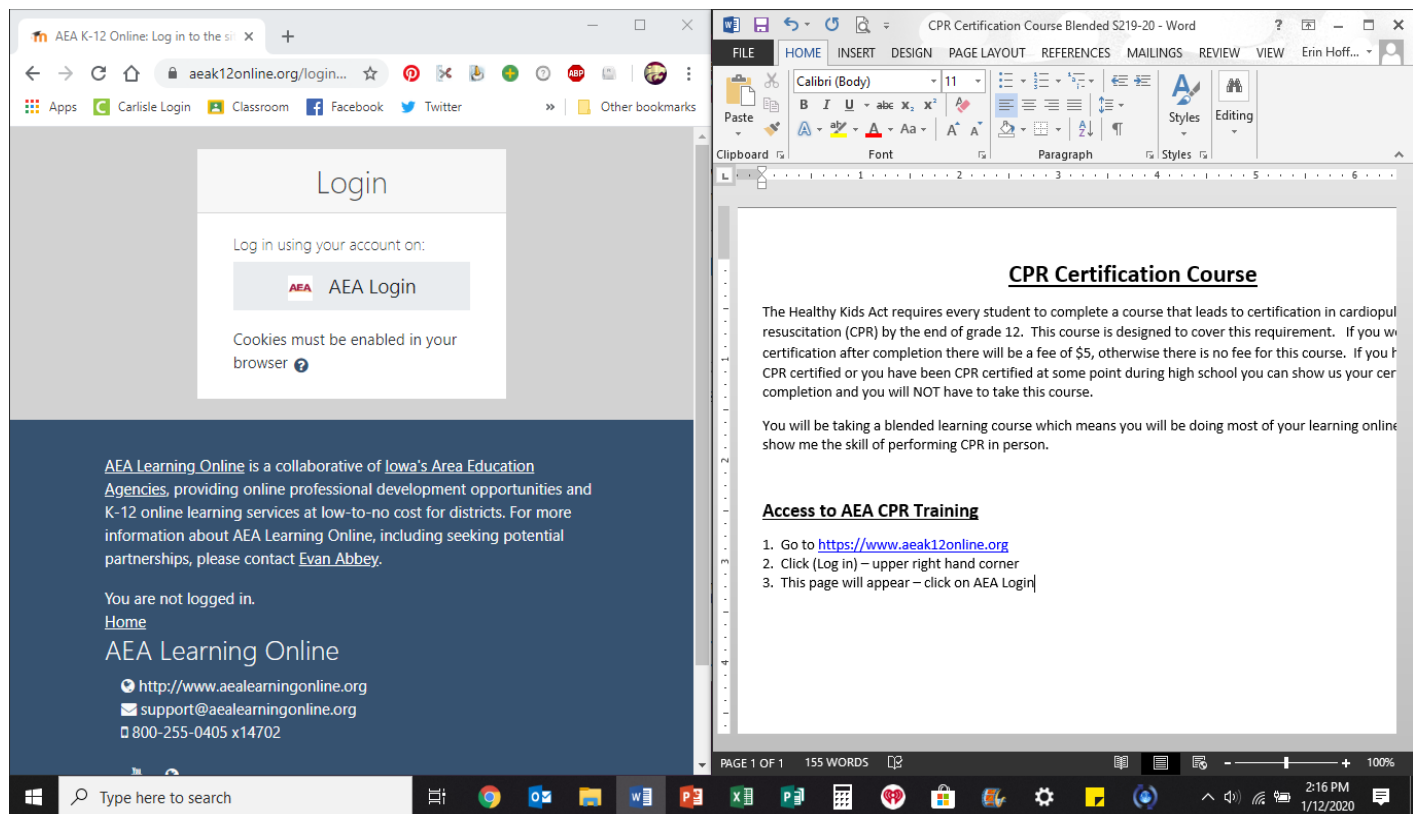

1. Go to <https://www.aeak12online.org>
2. Click (Log in) – upper right hand corner

3. This page will appear – click on AEA Login



4. Log in using google account. Use your school email address.

5. Click that you are a student, type in your school Carlisle High School (it will appear in the dropdown). Then enter the school code: je4258

6. After it verifies, fill in the rest of the information (first and last name and graduation year)

To enter a Moodle course do one of the following:

1. Input course code above. This is a **6-character alphanumeric** code provided by your instructor. Once you have done so, your course will then be listed in the **My Courses** area below.
2. Click the QR code button above. Take a picture of the QR code provided by your instructor.
3. Click on **Go To Course** button above. Then input course number. This is a **4-digit** number provided by your instructor. The site will then ask you for an enrollment key, this can be anything that your instructor chooses. Once you enter your enrollment key successfully, the course will be listed in your **My Courses** area below.
4. Click on **Go To Course** button above. Click **click here** to find the course. Navigate the folders to find the course. Folder structure is AEA>District>Building>Discipline>Subject>Course>Teacher.

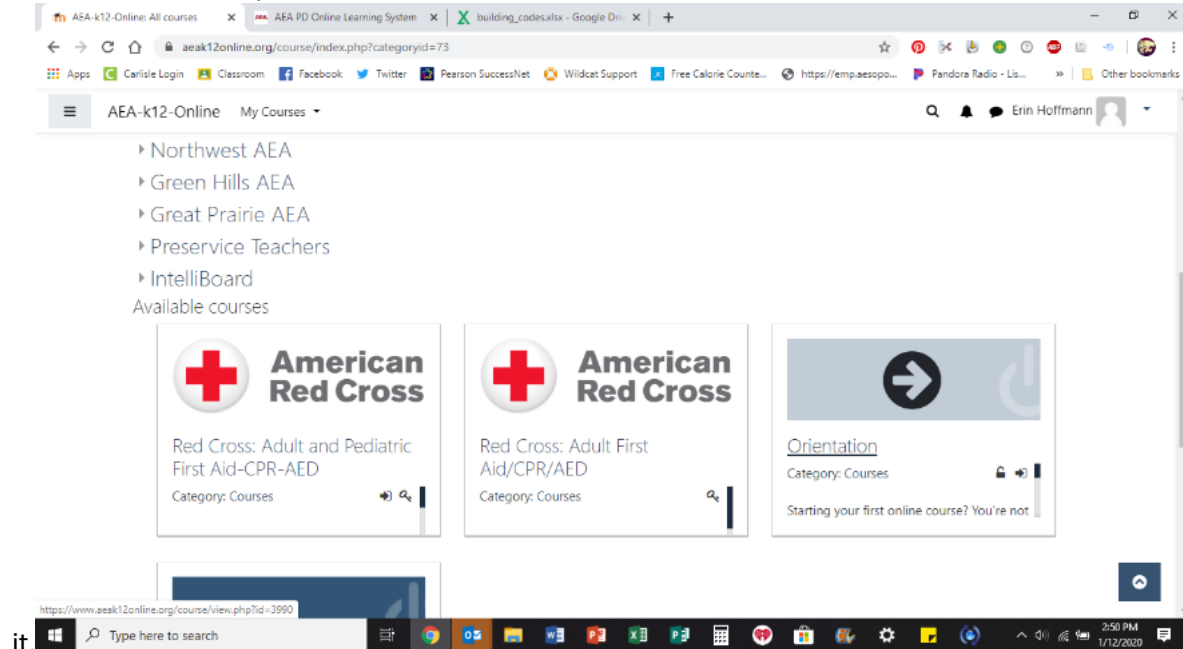

9. Scroll down until you see American Red Cross – Red Cross: Adult First Aid/CPR/AED and then click on

12. When you have completed all of the missions you will need to print off a certificate that shows your completion.
